POSITION SUMMARY

The City of Cashmere has openings for wastewater and/or water system operators. Candidates should be a team player, eager to learn, take initiative, and work effectively alone or in a team environment. The small department provides for a variety in work duties, and opportunities to obtain certifications in other areas of water and/or wastewater operations, collections, and distribution. The positions are demanding and rewarding for the person interested in making a difference in the community where they work. Position placement and pay is dependent upon experience and qualifications.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

Performs the following with or without supervision depending on certification level:

- Operates wastewater or water treatment plant
- Collect, monitor, sample and report data
- Diagnose information to determine corrective actions or to improve system performance
- Construct/maintain/repair water and sewer pump stations, main lines, man holes, meters, gages, and control valves
- Manage and monitor electrical control systems (telemetry)
- Employs safe work practices
- Review plans, maps and programs
- Operate tools/equipment
- Responds to, and addresses, water and wastewater emergencies
- Responds to routine customer service calls

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

- Water or Wastewater Operator certification (OIT, Level 1, 2 or 3)
- High school diploma or GED; with additional education and experience necessary for successful performance of this job
- Valid Washington state driver's license (commercial driver's license desired)
- First-Aid and CPR certifications

WORKING CONDITIONS

- Work is performed in both inside and outside environments subject to all weather conditions
- Operations include working in confined spaces, machinery, electricity, equipment and laboratory chemicals
- Subject to heavy lifting
- Working around all types of equipment where safety is critical
- Occasionally work after-hours, weekends, holidays, and on-call status
